Love and Kindness Youth Summer Camp is hosted by Love and Kindness Independent Church in Spencer and is open to any child age 5 years to 18 years of age that would like to spend 2 and half days having great fun and learning about the goodness of God. Space is limited and the deadline to register is July 18 to receive a t-shirt. Because of extensive fund raising by the church, cost is limited to just \$25 for the first 40 campers and \$50 for each additional. Any registration received after July 18 will be \$50 and no t-shirt will be provided. Otherwise, all meals, snacks, T-shirts and lodging is included in the registration fee. Remember only those registered by July 18 are guaranteed a slot to attend and a t-shirt. All Adult Volunteers / Chaperones/Attendees will be charged \$25 each which includes meals and t-shirts if paid by July 18. Yes, adults that will attend any part of the camp or camp activities will be charged \$25. If you are interested in being a chaperone or volunteer, please call in advance to see if a position is open.

Love and Kindness Youth Summer Camp Rules:

- 1) Children between age 5 through 18 are welcome to attend camp. Adults 19 and up may serve as volunteers / chaperones if needed. Registration fee is required. See form for details.
- 2) Campers must be willing and are expected to participate in the activities of the camp.
- 3) No cell phones, iPods, game units are to be used during camp activities. They may be used during “down time” but Love and Kindness and Spring Heights is not responsible for lost items. There is no electric available to campers for charging of these items.
- 4) Swim suits are to be used at the pool. One or two piece suits may be worn. Parents should ensure the suits are appropriate for the camp. T-shirts may be worn in the pool for those wishing to do so.
- 5) Campers are to be respectful to each other, the chaperones, camp directors, etc. Any camper that has a problem with another camper or staff member should report it to Toby or Kat ASAP to get the problem fixed.
- 6) Children should not to be picked up early. Most children enjoy being away from home. However, sometimes they want to go home. We do our best to talk them into staying. Parents who visit as day volunteers/chaperones are encouraged not to take their children home. Any child taken home early may not return later.
- 7) All medications must be administered through the Spring Heights Education Center medication office.
- 8) Campers that are boyfriend/girlfriend are not to hold hands, or show public displays of affection. This is a church camp. Those not abiding by this rule, will be sent home.
- 9) Cabin assignments are based upon age/gender. Love and Kindness reserves the right to swap bunks if a child is unable to use or get up onto the top bunk.
- 10) **Absolutely, no fans, coolers, snacks or electronic items should be brought.** Snacks are provided.
- 11) Any other rule that Love and Kindness needs to add to make camp fun, safe and exciting.

What do I need to bring or what do you suggest?

- ___ Swimsuit (one or two pieces is okay if appropriate) You'll swim two days.
- ___ 1-2 Towel(s) for the pool
- ___ Sunscreen lotion / insect repellent
- ___ Pillow, sheet, blanket and/or sleeping bag
- ___ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ___ Soap, Shampoo, washcloth and any other personal hygiene item(s) needed
- ___ Bible (if you don't have one, that's okay)
- ___ Outfit for Friday night, Saturday and Sunday. (might bring an extra one for emergency)
- ___ At least one pair of athletic shoes. Some activities will be difficult/impossible in flipflops.
- ___ Bring an extra pair or two of socks in case they get wet. You don't want blisters.
- ___ Positive attitude
